3. The candidates who are not complying with the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed by the Directorate will not be considered for assessment by respective Mercantile Marine Department (MMD). It is further clarified to all the candidates that if they take admission with the eligibility criteria below that of mentioned in the above mentioned DGS Training Circular 12 of 2020 will not be allowed by the MMD to appear for Certificate of Competency (COC) examination.
